


Install & Using Redirect Plugin

This document assumes you know how to install a plugin. But just in case here is a quick overview:

Depending on the speed of your host plugin will install within seconds.
Activate the plugin!

The plugin admin area serves three functions.

- 1) Shows you which posts you have redirected.**
- 2) Show you which pages you have redirected.**
- 3) Allows you to easily [edit](#) navigate to post/page to edit forwarding URL at any time.**

Using is as simple as creating a new post or page:

- Hide on the front page.
- Hide on category pages.
- Hide on tag pages.
- Hide on author pages.
- Hide in date archives (month, day, year, etc...)
- Hide in search results.
- Hide in feeds.
