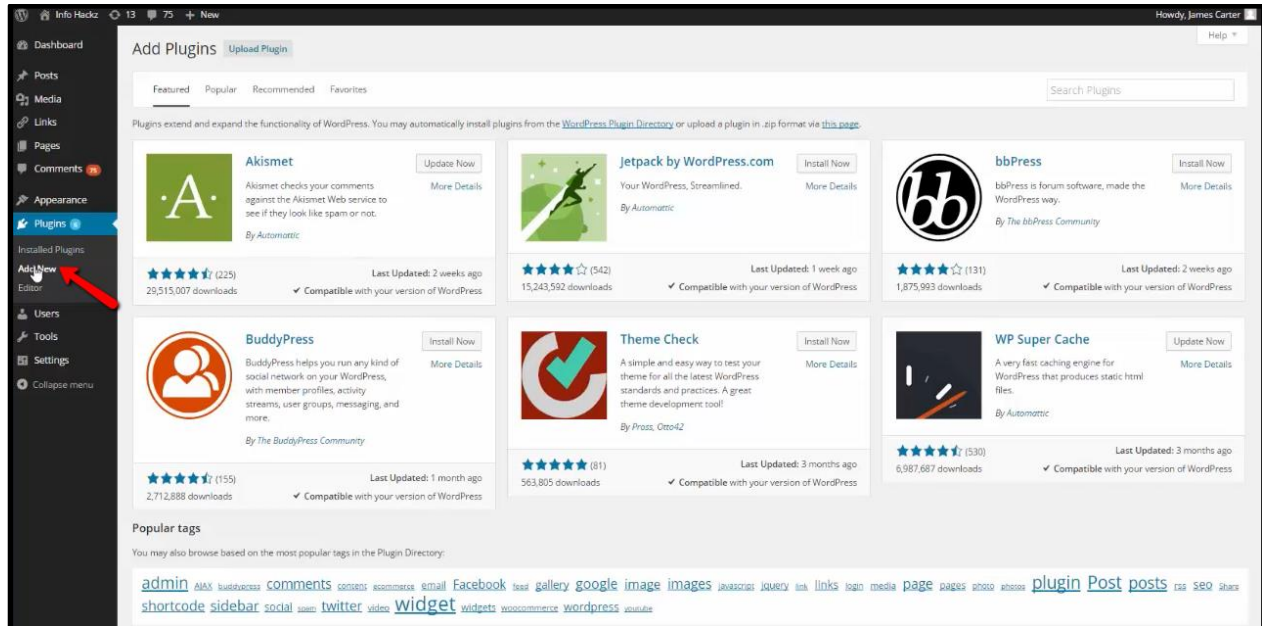


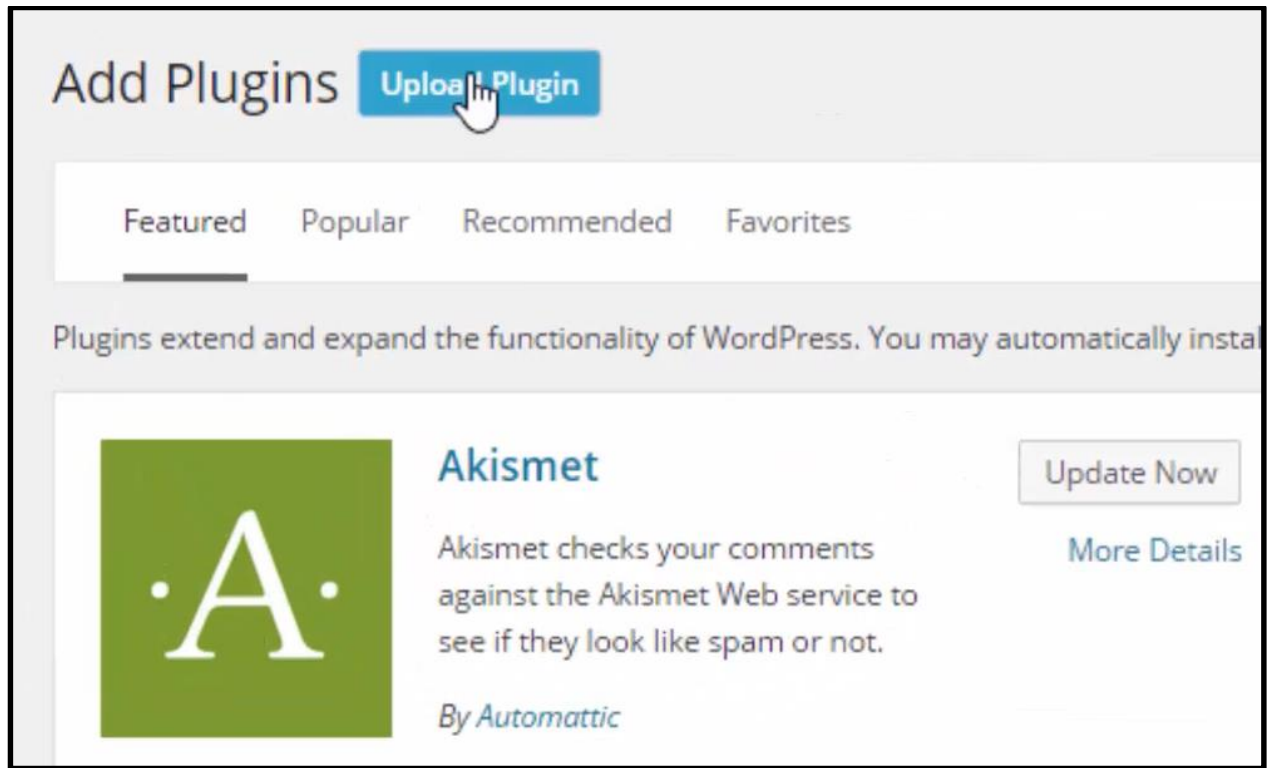
This tutorial will show you how to setup your Curation Hero plugin and add a social account that comes with your level of Curation Hero.

Step 1 – Log in to your Wordpress Dashboard.

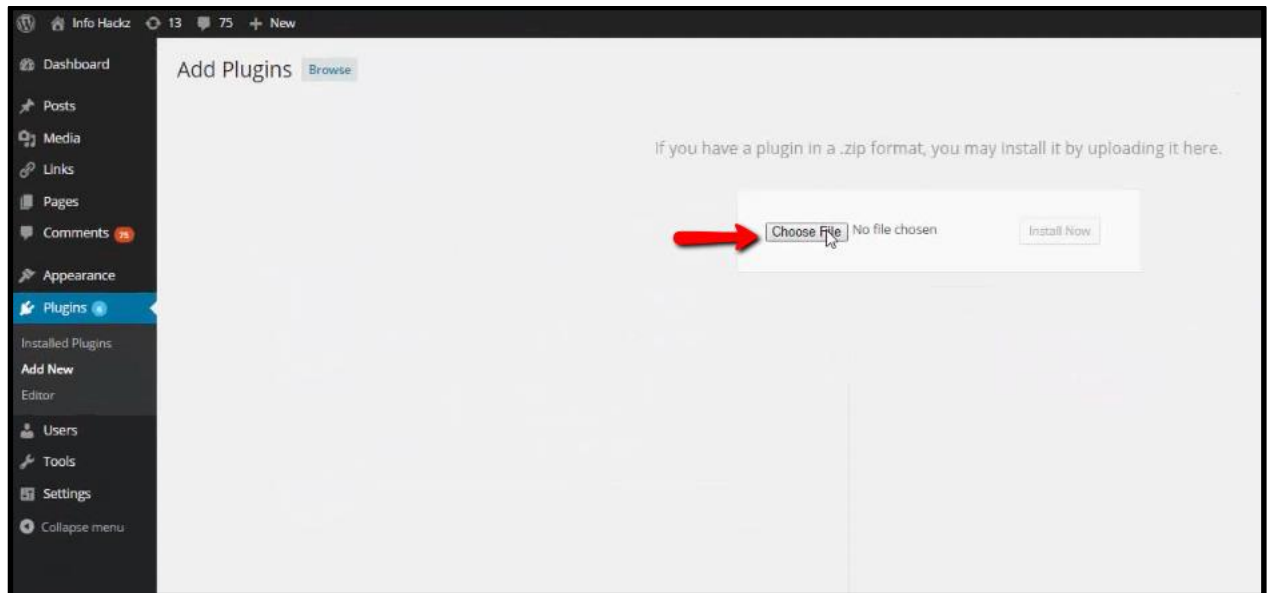
Step 2 – Navigate to Plugins section and click “Add New” to add a new plugin.



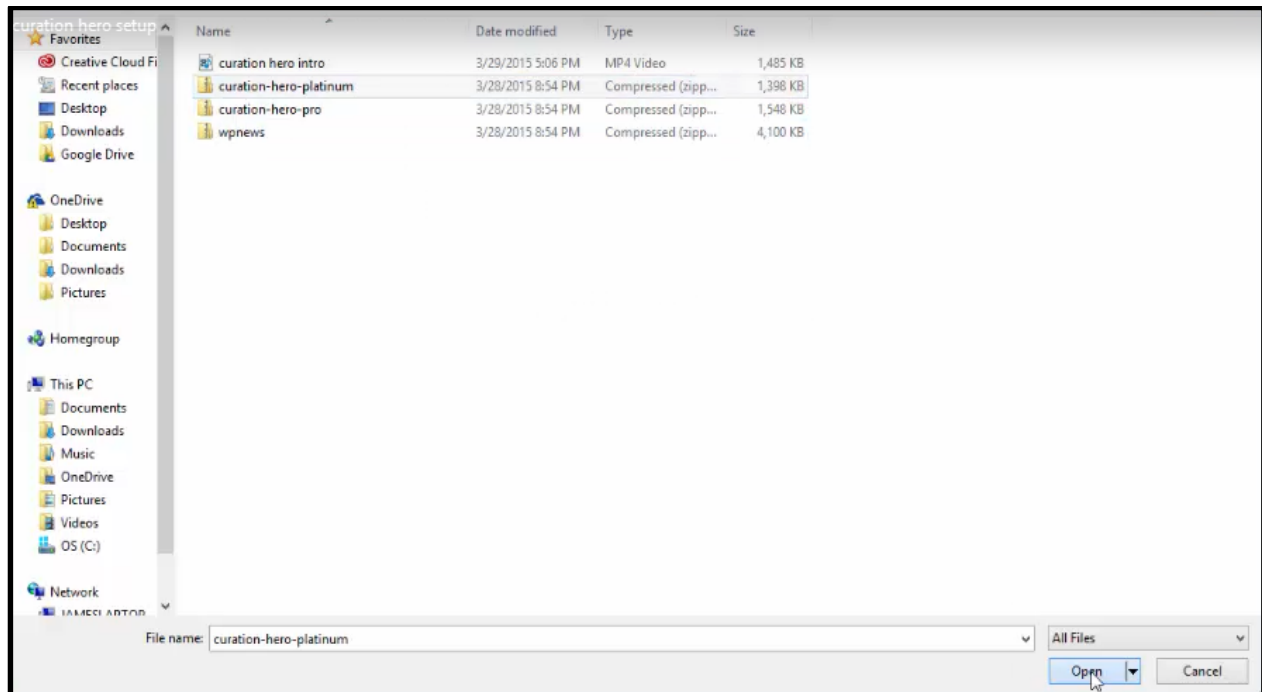
Step 3 – Click “**Upload Plugin**” button.



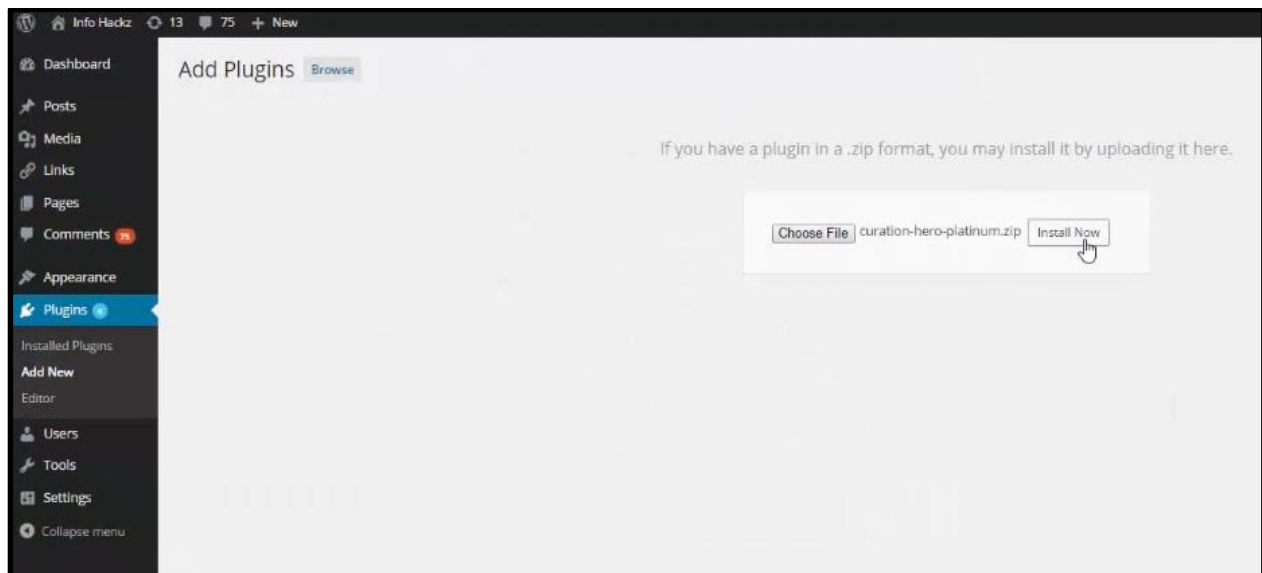
Step 4 – Click “**Choose File**” button and a new window will pop up.



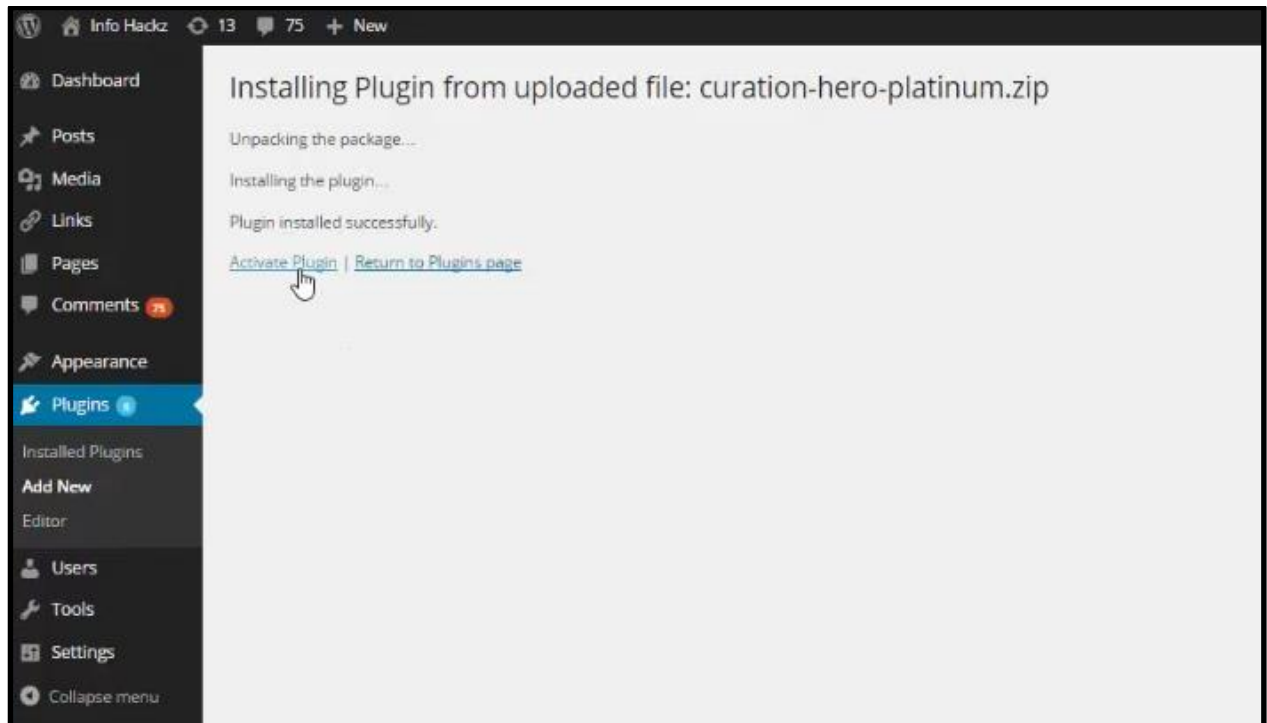
Step 5 – Select the file of the plugin you download earlier and click Open.



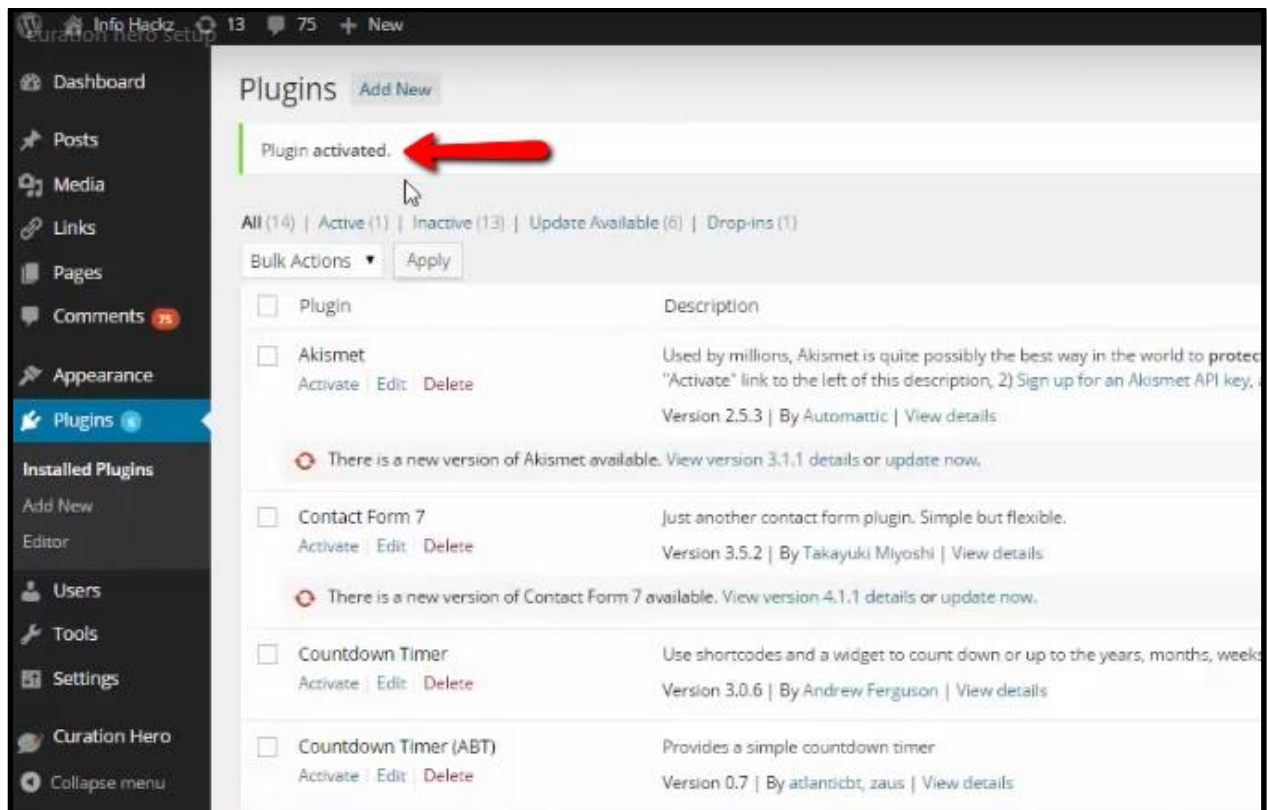
Step 6 – Now, click “**Install Now**” button to install it.



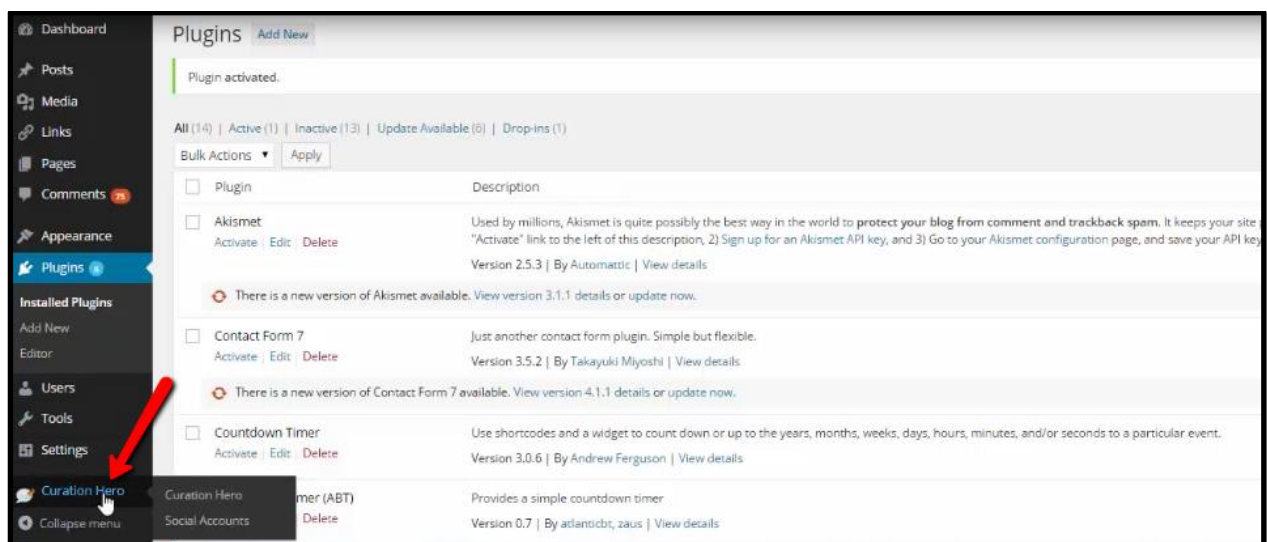
Step 7 – Click Activate Plugin to activate the plugin you just installed.



And it will show “**Plugin activated**” as indication that you have successfully enabled the plugin.

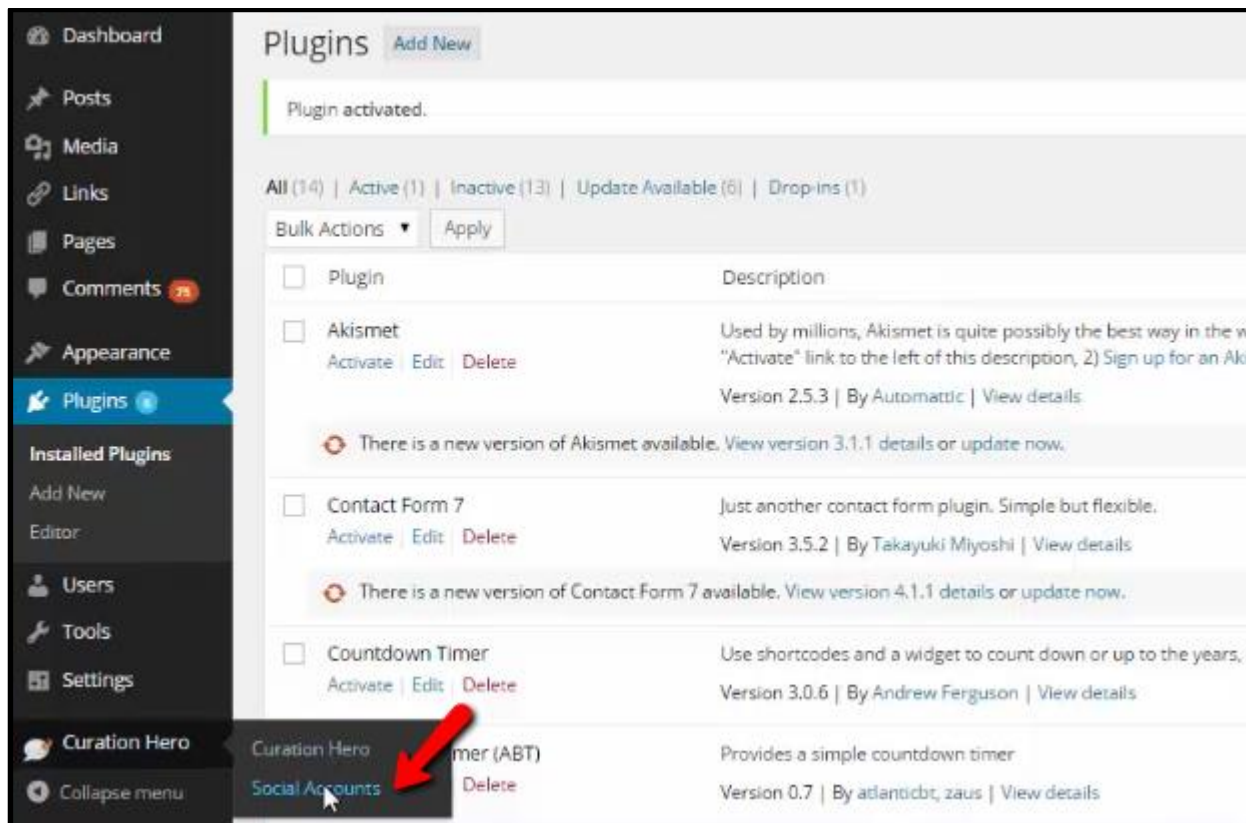


You will then see Curation Hero from your Dashboard menu:

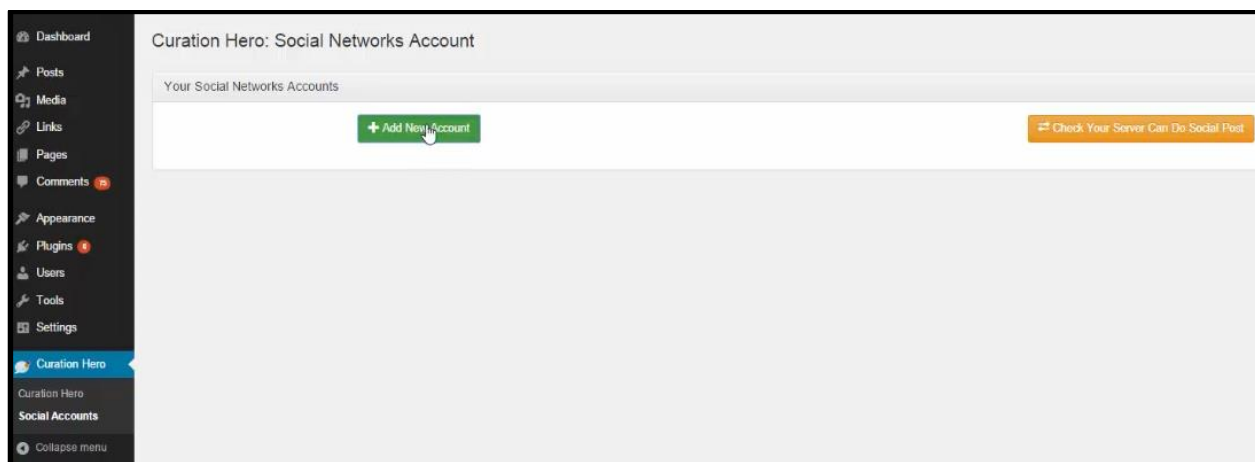


Note: The first time you click Curation Hero will require you to input your license details that you should have received shortly after purchased. If you didn't receive it, go ahead and contact Support.

Step 8 – Now, let's add a Social Account. Still in the **Curation Hero** section, select **Social Accounts**.



Step 9 – In this page, click “Add New Account” button.




Step 2: Authorize Account

Step 10 – In this example, we will setup Facebook.

In the **Select Network** dropdown, select Facebook. As you can see, every social account has a link to the guide where you can click on and it will walk you through the entire process on how to set those things up. It's pretty simple and straight forward.
