



This tutorial will show you the Pro features of Curation Hero.

**Step 1** – Log in to your Wordpress Dashboard.


**Step 2** – Navigate to Curation Hero Pro section from the left hand side and click Curation Hero.




In the Pro version, you get every features included and you have more options to source by.




**Step 3** – If you click Settings, you will also have the ability to add Amazon Affiliate ID.



**Step 4** – Now, I'm going to show you an example on how to curate from Amazon. From the source by, select Amazon.




And you will get this page:




As you can see in the Platinum version, you have also the editor integrated to your post builder.


**Step 5** – To add the content to your post, you can simply drag and drop it to the editor.




Step 6 – You can also click **Add to Title** button.




Step 7 – Add a Featured Image.

**Step 10** – If you choose Scheduled, you will get this option to select a date and time.





**Step 11** – Another great thing in the Pro version is that you can manage as many social accounts as you want but you also have a lot more social accounts to choose from. Let's go ahead and select Social Accounts.



## Setup/Installation: Blogger – Social Networks Auto-Poster for WordPress

Blogger can use built-in API (which is limited). Also it can benefit from the Google+ API Library if you have it installed. In that case all limitations will be lifted.

### Blogger Configuration

1. Connect Blogger to your WordPress.

1. Login to your WordPress Admin Panel, Go to the Settings->Social Networks AutoPoster Options.
2. Click green "Add new account" button, select "Blogger" from the list.
3. Fill Blogger Login and Password. Please note that WordPress is not storing your Blogger password in a very secure manner, so you better create a separate Blogger account for your website other than using your main Google account.
4. Enter the Blogger Blog ID. Log to your Blogger management panel and look at the URL:  
<http://www.blogger.com/blogger.g?blogID=8959085979163812093#allposts>. Your Blog ID will be:  
 8959085979163812093.
