

This tutorial will show you the steps on curating a content post using Curation Hero plugin.

Step 1 – Log in to your Wordpress Dashboard.


Step 2 – Click “**Curation Hero Pro**” from the left side menu.

Step 3 – In this page, enter your keywords on the search field. Click the dropdown menu to source by and click “**GO!**” button.


In this example, I’m going to use this information:

Keyword: Perfect Souffle

Source By: Google News



And you will get this page:



As you can see, on the left side you have your search results and on the right side is your post builder. You can go through checking your search results and look for items that will pick your interest.

Step 4 – Now, click “**Expand**” button to see the entire post content. In the Post Builder content area, add your brief introduction. Click “**Add All**” to add the entire content below your introduction message.

Step 5 – Let's add your post title and featured image.

Add your title in the Post Builder.

On the search field, enter your keywords again and source it by Youtube. On the left side, you will see your results. Look for the image that you wish to use and click **"As Featured Image"** button to set it as your Featured Image.

Step 6 – Adding video resources to your post. Look for the video that may interest you from your search results then simply drag and drop it to your Content area.



Step 7 – I'm going to show you another method on curating contents.


Enter your keywords on the search field and source it by Youtube. You will get a list of videos related to your search. What we can do is to list a number of videos to your content area.
