



1) Install Plugin :

Step 1

Before you add your first banner, we need to start a group. This is where you will putting your banner files, it is also how each YouTube video on your site decides what banners to show up.

5) Manage Group :

Once you have added a group, you want to change the video settings to suit your site. You can always leave this for now and edit later, if you do that default settings will be given.

7) Add New Banner :

Once you have set a group of your banners, you can make all the videos on your site show that set of banners via the settings tab. By default it will show only one group across all videos.

If you want to change the banners shown in a particular video, you can do it manually via the post as shown below:

8) Set Banner In Page or Post Information :

As you can see in the above image, this is also where you can edit the timing for banners.

This means if you have more than 1 banner in a group you have made, you can select the timing between pop up.

For example, image 1 can show up 1 seconds into the video when user presses play, image 2 can show up 3 seconds after that etc.

You can also set how long you want the banners to show up for, in the above image the banner is set to show for 10 seconds.

Tips for Using Plugin

-Internet Marketers can insert buy now buttons or “click here” type banners

-Affiliates can insert CPA banners and other offers

-Insert a Gif to really get the customers attention

-If ANYONE is watching a video on your site, these banners WILL get their attention, be creative and get them clicking!!
