

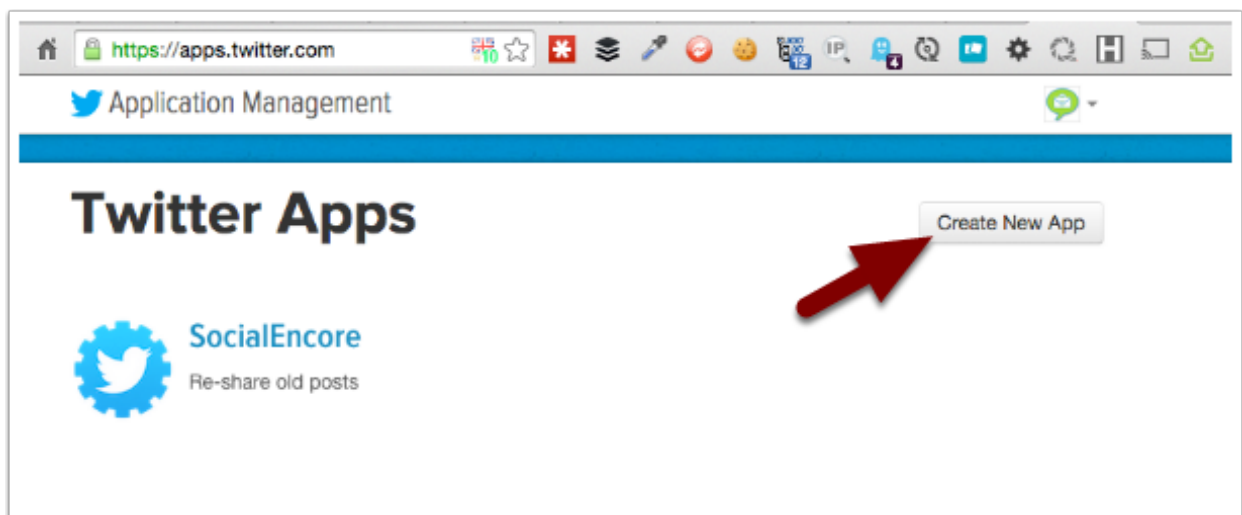
Twitter App Setup Guide

This document walks you through the process of setting up a Twitter app and obtaining API keys and secret tokens necessary for plugin integration.

Access Twitter Application Management

Go to <https://apps.twitter.com/>

Click Create New App



Create an application

1. Enter a name for your app
2. Give your app a description
3. Enter your website URL for this app
4. Enter your website URL here (where the plugin is going to be used)



Application Terms

I. Twitter API and Twitter Content

A. Definitions

- 1. Content** - Tweets, Tweet IDs, Twitter end user profile information, and any other data and information made available to you through the Twitter API or by any other means authorized by Twitter, and any copies and derivative works thereof.
- 2. Developer Site** - Twitter's developer site located at <https://dev.twitter.com>.
- 3. End Users** - Users of your Services, who are bound to enforceable service terms with you.
- 4. Licensed Material** - A collective term for the Twitter API and Content.

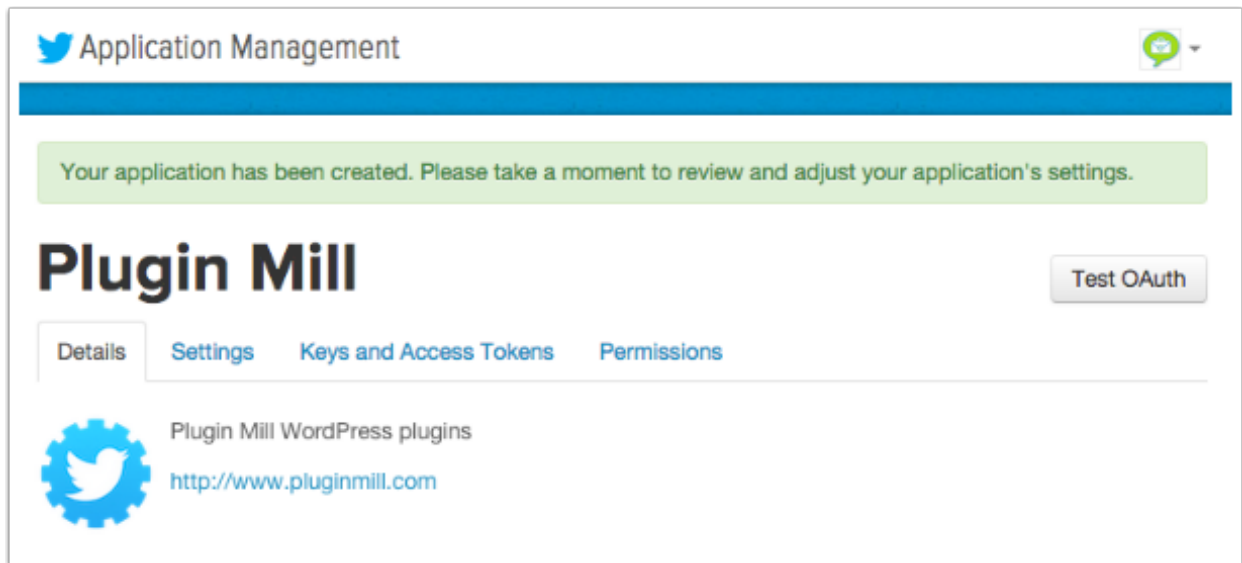

Once your app has been created successfully, you will see a message similar to this.

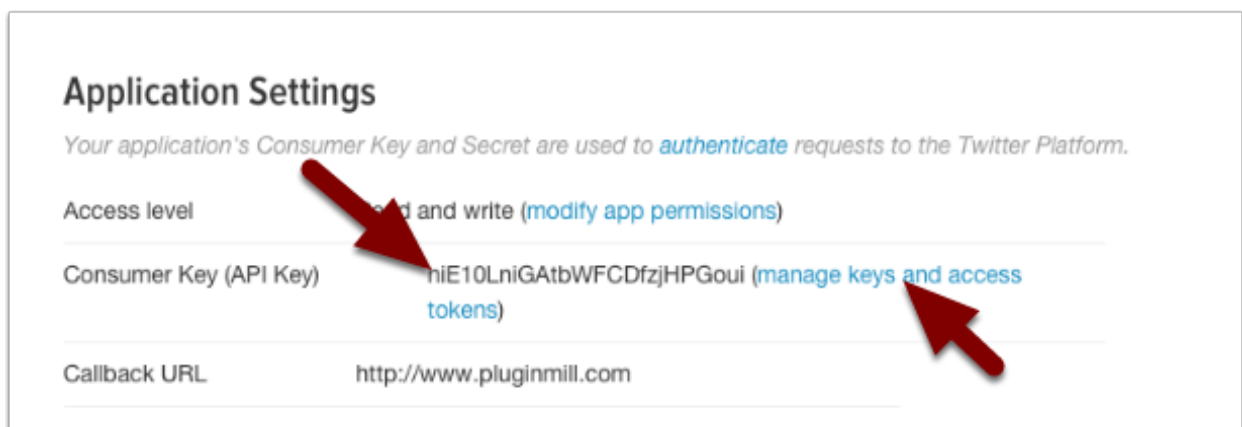

Consumer Key

Scrolling down the page, you will see Consumer Key (API Key) being displayed. Copy that you will need it. You can also copy it on the next page.

Consumer Key alone is not enough. You will need a secret and access tokens. Click manage keys and access tokens.

Consumer Secret

After clicking on manage keys and access tokens, this is what you will see. You can also access this by going to the Keys and Access Token tab.

You will be shown your Consumer (API) Key again which you will need for the plugin.

You will also need your Consumer Secret (API Secret). Copy these two for your plugin.

Application Settings

Keep the "Consumer Secret" a secret. This key should never be human-readable in your application.

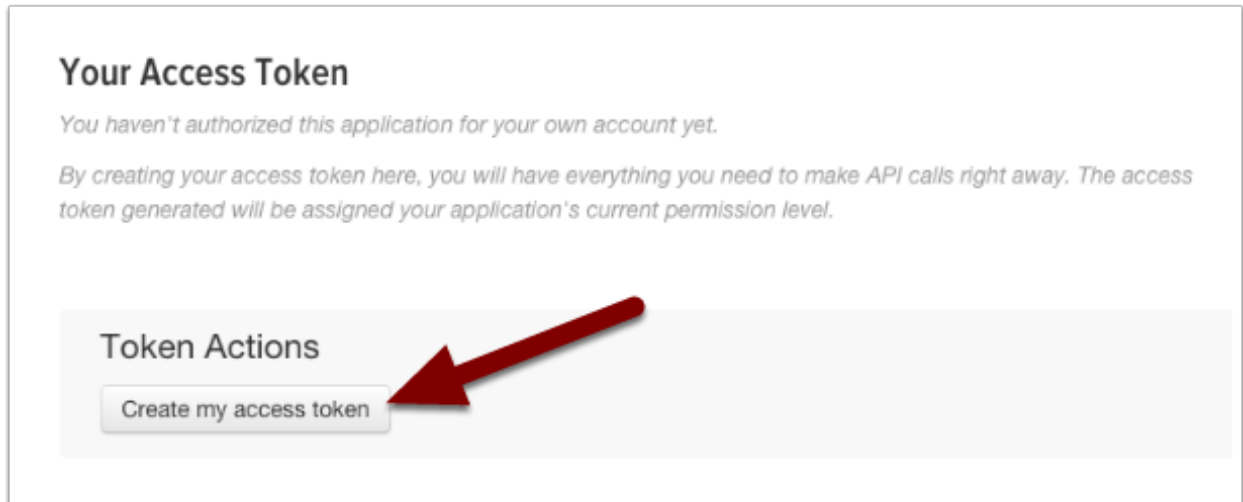

Create Access Token

As mentioned earlier, Consumer and Secret Keys alone are not sufficient. You need two more items. Start by clicking on Create my access token (same page as Keys and Access Tokens)

Access Token Created

1. After you click to create the token, you may encounter a message on the top of your screen like this one. Scroll down the page to retrieve your token.
2. You will need the Access Token and the Access Token Secret. Copy these into your plugin.
