# Installing “WPSellMore!”.

Installing the plugin is like installing any other WP plugin.

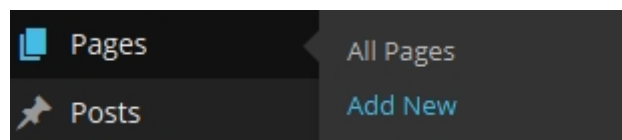
**Step 1:** Go to the "Plugins" section and click.

**Step 2:** Click "Add New" and Upload the included zip file.

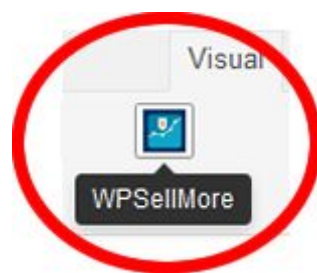
**Step 3:** Activate "WPSellMore!".

# Using “WPSellMore!”.

After activating the plugin, create a New WordPress Page or Post as you usually do.



You'll see the “WPSellMore!” icon in your editor.



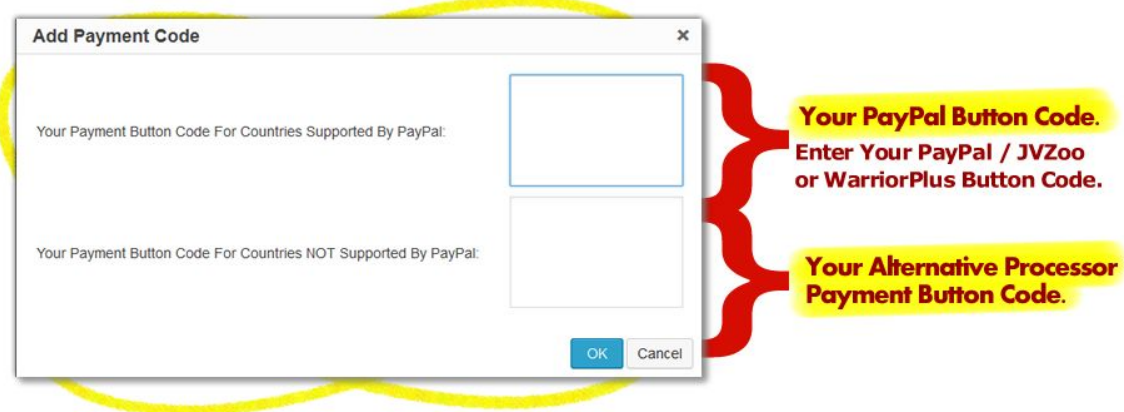
You'll use this button to insert a payment button in the place of your choice.

You'll see a window where you need to enter...

1) Your PayPal Button Code. This Button Will be displayed to visitors from countries where PayPal is supported.

An Alternative payment button (2co.com, ClickBank etc). This alternative payment processor will be displayed to visitors from countries where PayPal is NOT supported.

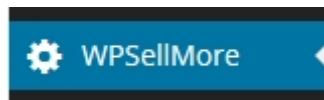

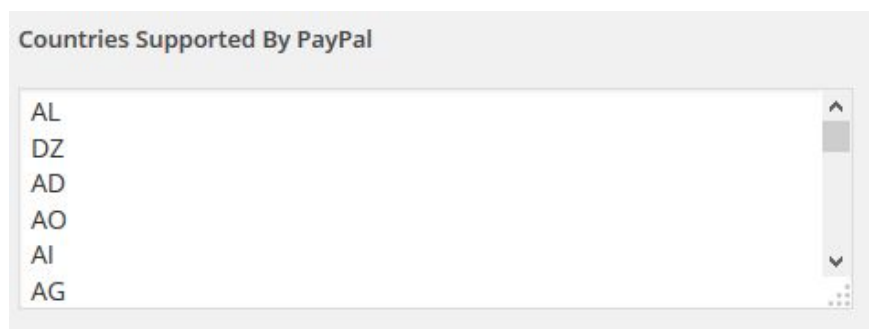

## “WPSellMore! Settings

You can find the settings menu under the Admin Area (left bar).

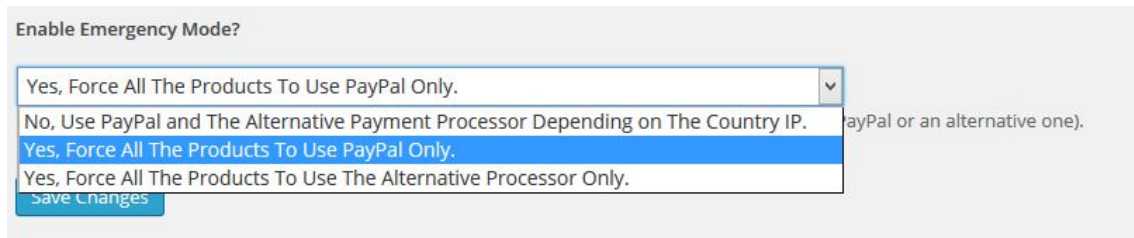


Here you can see the list of countries that are supported by PayPal.



Tip: These countries were supported by PayPal at the moment of developing this plugin. If you need to add more to this list, you are free to do it.

Finally, you'll find a GREAT extra feature (called "Emergency Mode") that can help you a lot (hope that you don't need to use it :) ).



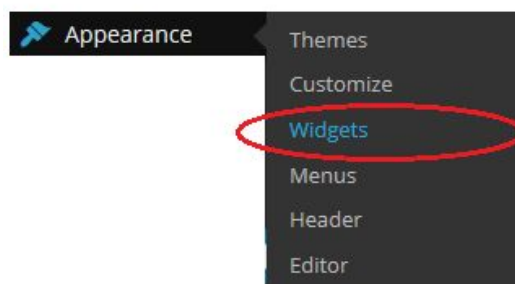
This feature allows you to force all the products (that you've created with WPSellMore!), to work with a SPECIFIC payment processor of your choice.

For example: If you have a temp. PayPal account limitation, you can force ALL of your products to show the payment button of your alternative processor (ClickBank etc). This way you always keep selling.

## **“WPSellMore!” Can Be Added To a Widget .**

If your theme supports widgets, you can do the payment switch by adding the “WPSellMore!” widget to it.

You'll find the “WPSellMore!” widget here...



Locate the “WPSellMore!” widget and paste the shortcode buttons that you've added to another post or page, inside your widget.

Comments: You can only add 1 product to a widget.
