Plugin Installation

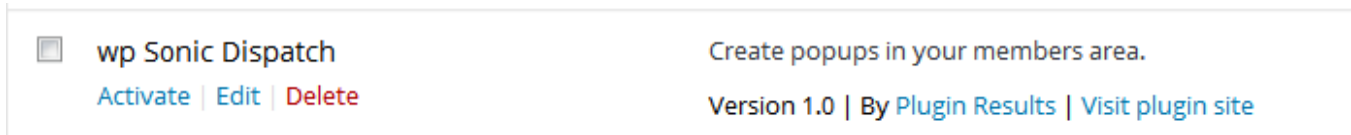
The Sonic Dispatch plugin installs like any other standard WordPress plugin.

Step 1: Upload Plugin

Use the Add New WordPress feature (Plugins | Add new) to upload the plugin file: SonicDispatch-1.0.zip

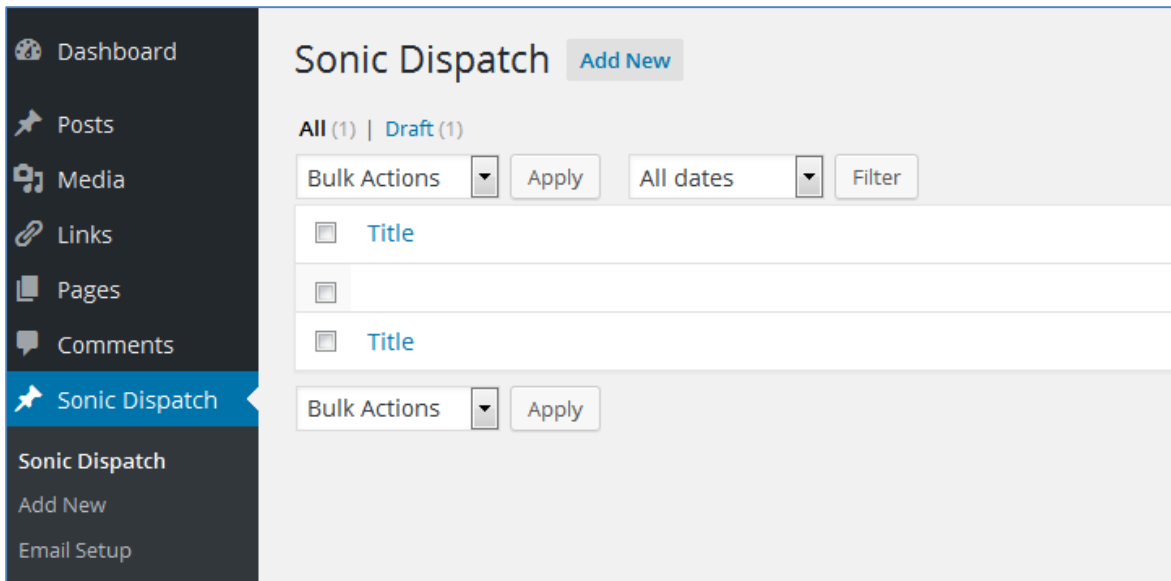
Step 2: Activate the Plugin

Activate the plugin.

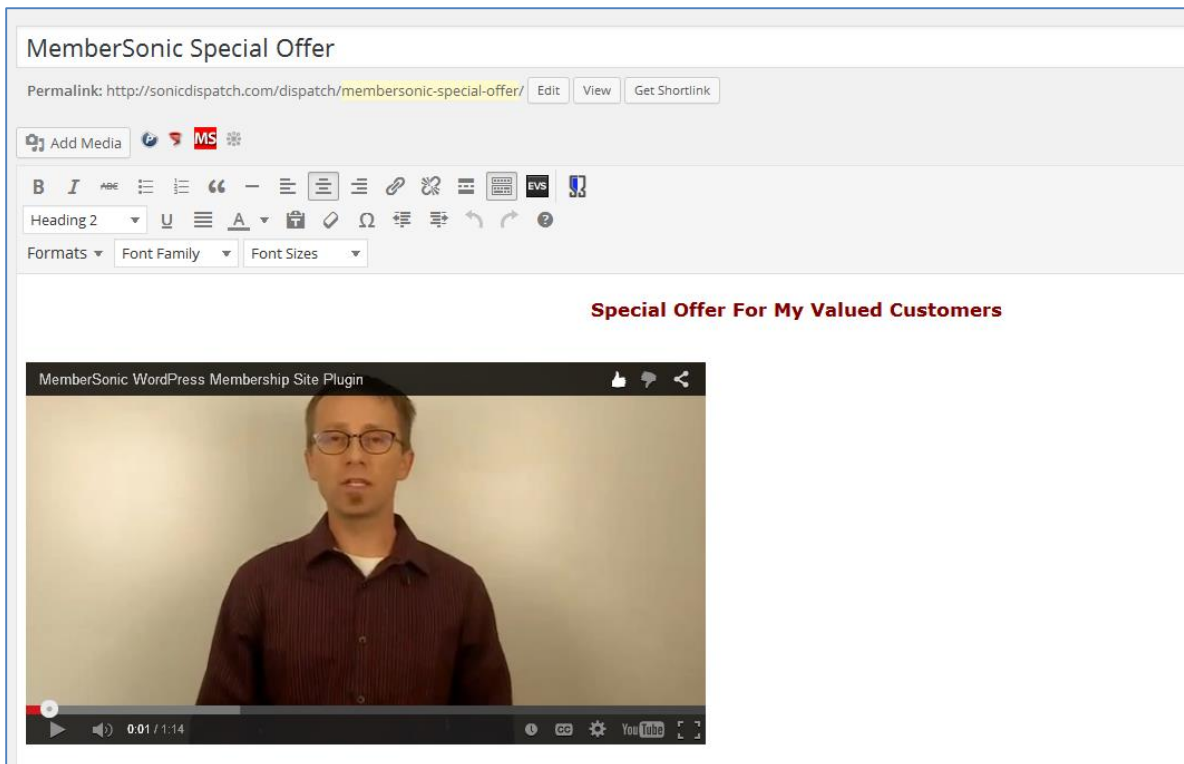


Creating A Popup Campaign

Click on the Sonic Dispatch link in the WordPress admin panel. To create a new popup, click on 'Add New'.



Add your popup content in the WordPress editor.



Scroll down to 'Dispatch Setup' and enter the desired dimensions of your popup content. You may have to tweak the width and height several times depending on the content within the popup.

Dispatch Setup	
Popup Width (px):	<input type="text" value="520"/>
Popup Height (px):	<input type="text" value="500"/>

Select the page that will display the popup. This may be any page within the members area (the dashboard page is a good choice).

Assign Pages:

Select the frequency of which you want the popup to display to your members. Select from Once, Twice or Always.

Email Notifications

In the WordPress admin panel under 'Sonic Dispatch', click on 'Email Settings'. Here you can create an email notification to send to all of your subscribers in your WordPress database.

Enter your 'From' name and email address.

Enter an email subject.

Enter the body of the email. There are a number of dynamic tags that you can use within the body of the email (#Username#, #E-mail#, #Notification Title#, #Notification Content#).
