



Instruction Manual

Using the software is relatively easy. There are only 5 questions that you need to fill in the blanks and then you click the finish button to create your List Builders Super Pack mini-sales funnel.

As easy as it is we'll go over each question one by one just in case you do have problems.

Question #1 "Enter Your Full Name Here"

Pretty self explanatory, just enter your full name. This will be used on various pages throughout the site and on the built in OTO page.

Question #2 "Enter Just Your First Name Here"

Again pretty self explanatory, just enter your full name. This will be used on various pages throughout the site and on the built in OTO page.

Question #3 "Enter A Site Registration Code"

This is a security measure to keep people from finding your members area registration page and setting up bogus accounts. Just make up some code that won't be easily guessed. You should write this code down for future reference if you ever need to manually add an account to the member's area.

Question #4 “Paste in your autoresponders webform code here”

You get this from inside your autoresponder account. This is used on the optin page you will be creating for getting list signups. This can be either the short javascript version or the full HTML code.

Question #5 “Enter Your Paypal Generated Button Link Here”


This is probably the hardest to explain. Basically you need to login to your Paypal account and create a “Buy Now” button for selling the List Building Manifesto one time offer. You want to set the price to be \$17 for this sale. You can change the price if you want to but that will mean you will need to edit the otopage.html manually to reflect the new price.

The important thing to remember is that we don’t want the actual button code but instead the URL you get from the “Email” tab of step three of creating the button.

3. Find the section of the page where you want your button to appear.
4. Right-click and paste your button code into the HTML.
5. Save and publish the page. (The preview function in your editor may not display the button code correctly.)
6. Test the button to make sure it links to a PayPal payment page.

That’s about all there is to it. Once you’ve answered all 5 of these question and click the finish button the software will ask where you want to save the generated files to. Most people create a folder on their desktop since that’s the easiest place to find folders you created.

The only thing that’s left to do now is to transfer the files to your website. When doing so transfer all of the files created and the folders there were created. This will make sure that all of the pages created are linked together properly.

The best way to transfer the files is with a FTP program. You can get Filezilla for free as well as FireFTP for the Firefox web browser. Just do a search on Google for these and you will find the download places and instructions on how to use them.

Final Notes:

- 1) Included inside the “membersarea” folder is a file named bonus.html. If you want to add any extra bonuses to your members area just open this file with any HTML editor you choose and add the code to bonus in this file. Save it and then upload it to the membersarea folder on your website.
- 2) You probably should rename the signup.html to something people won't be able to guess the name of it. Just add some random letters or numbers to the end of it will be sufficient. Example: signupwd234.html
- 3) Be sure and edit the 1st Email.txt file before loading it into your autoresponder. You should include the exact URL to your member's area signup page in this first email.
- 4) One final note, make sure your autoresponder is set to redirect to the redirect.html file so that when you do get a list signup they are sent to the otopage.html page. This is how you get the \$17 OTO sales by doing this.
