

To rebrand / change the plugin name, you can do it with the following steps:

1. Change the folder of the plugin with the name you want. Names can only consist of letters, numbers, characters dash (-), the underscore (_) and or a period (.).
2. Rename the file wp-social-widget.php with a name corresponding to the name of the folder (step 1)
3. Change the information in the file wp-social-widget.php, as follows:
